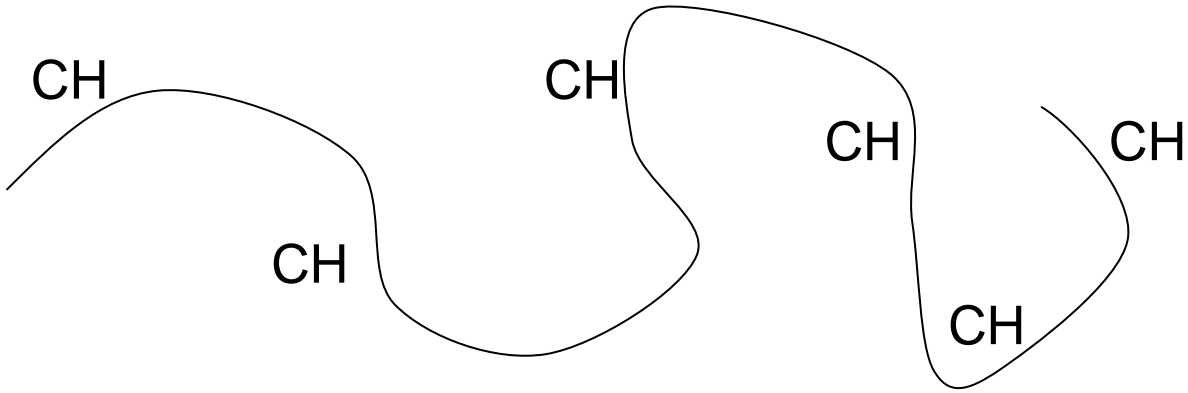


CH Isolation
